A1: The day department (including five colleges, four skills and research institutes) will be charged for semesters, and the further education department will be charged for credits, please refer to for details Read the Tuition and Fees Fee Schedule on the Accounts Office website.

A2: Yes, but there will be a non-refund standard due to the different time of leave and withdrawal, please refer to the website of the Accounting Office for the refund standard Leave and Withdrawal Refund Standard Table.

A3: You can pay at the four major supermarkets before the specified payment deadline, or pay at the bank counter, or you can use ATM transfer. Or pay by credit card, Taiwan Pay.

A4:1.You can use various exemption and exemption measures, disadvantaged student assistance programs, or apply for various scholarships and grants inside and outside the school (please contact the course guidance organization.) Sorting machine 604) 2. You can apply for a student loan (please contact the student assistant group for extension 605) 3. You can consider paying tuition and miscellaneous fees in installments at zero interest rate from each bank (please contact the original card-issuing bank). 4. If you do not meet the above application conditions and have the desire to study but do have financial difficulties, the school may consider giving it after assessment Interest-free installment loan (please contact the accounting office for extension 224).
